OSV is offering tours in the Spanish language

STURBRIDGE — Old Sturbridge Village has gone bilingual and is offering daily tours in Spanish.

The 45-minute Spanish language tours — which run daily through Aug. 8 and then will be offered weekly year round are free with museum admission, and are led by a Spanish-speaking OSV historian in costume.

“At OSV, the entire family can watch the “herrero” (blacksmith) at work; see a farmwife make “morcilla” (black pudding), and ride the “diligencia” (stagecoach),” said Deb Friedman, the museum’s director of public programs. “And they can all share the same memories of an entertaining and enriching experience.”
